













### Across:

- 2 a woodwind instrument made of a hollow wood or (silver) metal tube closed at one end. Sound is created by blowing into a mouthpiece near the closed end.
- 4 a brass instrument with 3 valves that is used in orchestras and bands, also called euphonium.
- 5 a single-reed woodwind instrument made of brass, invented by Adolphe Sax.
- 6 a brass instrument with a long, u-shaped slide instead of valves.


### Down:

- 1 single-reed woodwind instrument made of wor or plastic, usually black with silver keys.
- 3 oval-shaped brass instrument with 3 valves, usually lacquer or cilver plated.
